## A Message to our Communities from Wawa and The Wawa Foundation

It was another incredible year for Wawa and The Wawa Foundation, full of supporting, caring for and giving back to our communities. In this annual report, we will provide highlights of our 2021 giving across our focus areas, by Region, and we will share how our community support programs continue to connect our associates, customers and communities through a passion for care.

Of course, giving back to our communities is deeply embedded in Wawa's history. It is a key part of our culture and our purpose of Fulfilling Lives, Every Day. Today, this long-standing tradition includes The Wawa Foundation, as our primary source of financial grants to charitable partners, and Wawa, Inc., which provides additional financial support, as well as in-kind support through its Community Care team, and the Wawa associate volunteers, who dedicate their time and efforts to others throughout their communities. Our giving programs and strategies continue to reflect our commitment to causes related to Health, Hunger and Everyday Heroes.

While 2021 was again impacted by the pandemic, our over 37,000 associates and millions of customers continued to respond generously with their time and resources to support our communities by helping them overcome ongoing hurdles associated with providing the financial support and services that their communities rely upon.

In 2021, Wawa and The Wawa Foundation contributed \$16.3 million in financial grants and in-kind support to causes related to health, hunger and everyday heroes. Wawa stores donated more than 3.5 million pounds of excess food from daily operations, enough to provide more than 2.9 million meals to our neighbors in need. Both Wawa and our associate volunteers supported our charitable partners' events and other efforts by delivering or handing out coffee and snacks, or simply by being a positive presence to show our unique brand of community care. The Wawa Foundation also successfully launched a new "key issue grant fund," our second in what is expected to be an annual effort, for Breast Cancer Awareness and Support, enabling us to respond in a focused way to a critical issue as identified by our associates and customers. We also dedicated and formalized new ways for every Wawa store to connect with community service organizations, including first responders, health care heroes and teachers, through newly established store-to-community touchpoints on Wawa Hoagie Day and through our Cheers to Classrooms initiative. Both provided opportunities for stores to identify local community service providers and connect with them through deliveries of donated food products or through awareness of opportunities for financial support.

There is no question – none of this would be possible without the generous support of our customers and associates. Through their generosity, Wawa and The Wawa Foundation have contributed nearly \$120.0 million since The Wawa Foundation's inception in 2014, reaching more than 6,000 non-profit charities. In addition, Wawa stores have donated more than 26.6 million meals through the Wawa Share food donation program.

We want to thank everyone for making 2021 an incredible year for our community support efforts. To our customers, whose generosity to our in-store fundraising campaigns enables us to invest in building stronger communities, to our non-profit partners, who make a difference in the lives of so many, to our Wawa associates, who keep us all connected, live our values and continue to make life better for the friends and neighbors we all serve – we are grateful.

That's what fulfilling lives is about at Wawa.



## **2021 Financial Highlights**

In 2021, financial grants were made by The Wawa Foundation to more than 1,800 non-profit organizations, including our seven National Partners. The funds come from donations by Wawa, Inc., its associates and from the generous donations by Wawa customers through our in-store campaigns. Approximately half of the collections from in-store campaigns benefit The Wawa Foundation's National Partners and the remaining collections support local and regional non-profit organizations in every community Wawa serves. Wawa associates from each region serve as Regional Representatives for The Wawa Foundation to help select and determine local and regional non-profit organizations receiving grants. The Wawa Foundation is fully committed to ensuring that 100% of all funds donated go directly to non-profits. Nearly all administrative expenses are covered by Wawa, Inc.

## **Highlights of Support**

**In-Store Campaigns:** Despite another challenging year, our in-store campaigns continue to be successful and have a tremendous impact on our National Partners' ability to provide their services to communities Wawa serves.

**National Partner Campaigns & Impact:** The Wawa Foundation ended 2021 with more than \$5.0 million raised in-store through coin, scan campaigns and coin round-up — all going to it's seven National Partners as follows:



**Direct Financial Grants:** For the year 2021, The Wawa Foundation has distributed more than \$8.6 million in grants to non-profit organizations providing services in our focus areas throughout communities across our footprint.

#### **Community Care and Volunteering**

Community Care events are funded by Wawa and intended to reach local, grass roots community organizations helping to connect our associates with their communities. In 2021, this support included in-kind product donations totaling more than \$860,000; on the ground support of events including coffee, beverages and snacks valued at more than \$511,000; and associate engagement through volunteerism at walks and fundraisers hosted by The Wawa Foundation partners.

## The Wawa Volunteer Center at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP):

This flagship program for Wawa and The Wawa Foundation includes a full-service volunteer center serving patients and families at CHOP, along with our signature Wawa Coffee and Care Cart, which serves hot and cold beverages to the families of children receiving care and their caregivers at CHOP. In 2021, the program services included:

- Over 60 volunteers (reduced due to COVID restrictions)
- More than 75,000 beverages served in 2021 to patient families and healthcare heroes



#### The Wawa Foundation Board

Comprised of 13 Wawa associates, The Wawa Foundation Board governs the processes for fundraising, funds distribution, financial audits and compliance to our charter. Annually, The Wawa Foundation Board approves National Partners and they also determine grant recipients, sponsorships and contributions with local input from more than a dozen Wawa associates from around the Company who serve as the Foundation Regional Representatives.


