# Soaring to New Heights Together

Every year, on April 16, we reflect on two anniversaries — the opening of the first Wawa store in 1964 and the inception of The Wawa Foundation in 2014 — during Wawa's 50th anniversary. Our long history of giving and investing in our communities dates back to our founder Grahame Wood, who had the vision and belief in the importance of making a difference in the lives of those we serve. The year 2024 has been another incredible year with many milestones and new ways for Wawa and The Wawa Foundation to connect the good throughout the markets we serve and those to which we are expanding.

Over the past year, supporting our communities has been at the forefront of our expansion plans. With the help of our National Partners, The Foundation team connected with local and regional chapters to tour, listen and learn more about their priorities and the needs of our new communities. Our local associates have already started to impact lives and make connections in our new markets — supporting events and volunteer opportunities even before we open our doors. Our community-first approach will always lead our efforts as we expand to new markets.

Another key initiative in 2024 was the expansion of our Fly Beyond Key Issue Grant to fight food insecurity. Over the

next three years, Wawa and The Wawa Foundation have a goal to provide support for over 60 million fresh, nutritious meals available to children across the company's service area through this initiative. Last year, Fly Beyond included Key Issue Grants providing \$1.5 Million in funding to our Check-Out Hunger food bank partners. In addition, our inaugural Fly Beyond partner, Second Harvest Food Bank of Central Florida, continued to expand their program due to our continued investment to reach more than 58,000 households in the greater Central, Florida market with school partnership programs, school snack programs and weekend meal bags adding nutritious food and fresh produce.

We also continued to expand our reach and impact of the Wawa Volunteer Services at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP), by inspiring others to participate in programs benefiting patients and families served at CHOP. The inaugural *Helping Hands Community Care Challenge* sponsored by Wawa and The Wawa Foundation brought together hundreds of representatives from local companies to participate in a day of shared impact by assembling more than 14,000 care packages, school items and hygiene kits for patients and families as well as registering participants for future volunteer programs at CHOP throughout the year.

In addition to these impactful initiatives, this report will provide a look at our 2024 contributions and in-kind donations, which reached nearly \$25 million in giving and support. It will also highlight National Partner in-store fundraising campaigns along with local giving which reaches more than 3,500 non-profits annually.

Thank you to our Wawa associates and customers who believe in and support the missions of our many charity partners. Here's to soaring to new heights together and our shared purpose to connect the good and make a true difference in the lives of those we serve. As we continue to spread our wings to find new opportunities for growth, we look forward to our shared journey ahead.

## 2024 Financial Highlights


In 2024, financial grants were made by The Wawa Foundation to more than 3,500 non-profit organizations, including our seven National Partners. The funds come from donations from Wawa, Inc., its associates and from the generous donations by Wawa customers through our in-store campaigns. Approximately half of the collections from in-store campaigns benefit The Wawa Foundation's National Partners and the remaining collections support local and regional non-profit organizations in every community Wawa serves. Wawa associates from each region serve as Regional Representatives for The Wawa Foundation to help select and determine local and regional non-profit organizations receiving grants. The Wawa Foundation is fully committed to ensuring that 100% of all funds donated go directly to non-profits. Nearly all administrative expenses are covered by Wawa, Inc.


